The Texas Supreme Court has mandated that all civil and probate cases must be filed electronically, (efile), in Kaufman County, effective January 1, 2015.

In an effort to prepare for this new mandate, Kaufman County Clerk's Office began accepting E-filings for probate cases on June 18, 2014.

To maintain consistency, the County Clerk has adopted the e-filing requirements set forth in the Supreme Court rules (please see attached info).
